**Multisensory Structured Language Education:**  
*Level II – Certified*

**June 16-27, 2008 – 10 Day Course**  
8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

**Course Overview:** This is an advanced course for the remediation of a reading disability for the older student. The course is based on the Orton-Gillingham approach at the advanced level. It includes lecture, small group activities, hands-on practice teaching with an older student who has dyslexia/language learning delays, and observations of experienced multisensory structured language teachers working with adolescents.

**Specific Course Content:**

- An extension of all the Level I skills and curriculum
- Study of morphology (prefixes, roots, suffixes) and the advanced language structures of the English language
- Multisensory study skills to improve comprehension and organization
- Structured, systematic writing instruction
- Age appropriate teaching techniques and knowledge of the social and emotional aspects of dyslexia affecting older students
- Development of a student profile and the advanced lesson to match
- Understanding and interpretation of standardized testing and knowledge of assessment practices including formal and informal assessment measures
- Competence in case management and professional communication standards

**Prerequisites:** Interview with program director along with an assessment of Level I competence (knowledge of syllable types, spelling patterns, and basic teaching sequence), recommendation from Level I program instructor, prior MSLE teaching experience.

**Cost:** \$1300- includes all training books, manual, and materials, student teaching experience with individual support from an experienced MSLE Language Coach, daily light refreshments. \$100 deposit required with assessment of Level I competence.
